O'Fish Disblade Pin Trade Rules Adventure: Meet the Fodders

A New Breed of Pin

The Dog Club will hereby recognize only two types of Disblade Trading Pins:

1. **O'Fish Dogmass Pins** (*past, present, futchog*)
2. **Fodder**

The O'Fish Dogmass Pin category includes any O' Fish Disblade Trading Pin on an O'Fish Dogmass Lanyard, given aus at Dogmass, or any pin thematically tied to an O'Fish Dogmass World. (including worlds recognized as O'Fish Potential Dogmass Worlds, Best Gift or Potential best Gift pins, and Kingdom Hearts pins)

The Fodder category includes all other O'fish Disblade Trading Pins.

Why this Distinction?

Dogmass Pins are special. There needs to be a clear and clean distinction between a Dogmass Pin, and some tradebait non-Dogmass shog. A line needs to be drawn, and this is that line.

FODDER RULES: Assemble the Fodder

1. If a Dog wishes to maintain a public individual O'Fish Disblade Pin collection to be hooped up in the presence of other dogs, it must only contain fodder. (Any pins a Dog chooses to keep secret da foost behind closed NF doors are exempt from this addendum).
2. Fodder are nut subject to [these o'fish dogmass pin trading rules](#), and may only be traded for O'Fish Dogmass Pins with the express purpose of being surrendered ASAP to The Club Caché, OR as extra hoop in an otherwise legitimate O'Fish Pin Trade.

The Club Caché

It is the collective responsibility of every Dog in the club to contribute towards, maintain and utilize the communal Club Caché of pins. This is our warchest to strip the hooples of any buyge pins that could hoop up a Dogmass, current or futchog.

The Club Caché should generally avoid pins from previous Dogmass Worlds, unless it is for the purpose of gathering potential revisit pins.

The Club Caché will sometimes have some leftover pins that were collected for a particular Dogmass World but did nut end up making the cut. These pins should be offloaded ASAP.

It is also legitimate to utilize the Caché in order to sweeten a trade between yourself and a hoople for a pin from a previous Dogmass year.

(IE; Banjo Dog sees a hoople at Downtown Disblade with a Barbosa Stitch. F-er hooped, he offers to traded his grass skirty Stitch for Barbosa Stitch. The hoople declines the trade, but Banjo presents the Club's binder of pins, to see if the Hoople is interested in any of that shog in addition to grass skirty Stitch. The hoople finds some sold aus Star Wars pin and gets kended, snapping aus the trade. This is a legitimate usage of The Club Caché.)



Keep in mind The Club Caché contains many valuable pins for the sole purpose to securing buyge hoop pins for Dogmass, so tread ledgley. The Caché may also include pins from future dogmass years that many Dogs went to great lengths to secure.

Loss, abuse, negligence or other blatant mismanagement of The Club Caché will result in action taken by one if not several Dog Club Departments.
